

On 16th November 2021, Al-Ibrahim eye hospital began their collaboration with Indus Motors company to conduct free eye screenings in schools.

The main purpose of this activity was to provide door to door services during school timings due to the lack of accessibility especially during school hours where both parents and students had difficulty in consulting eye care services.

The project goal of IMC and AIEH: Increasing quality of life among the target population by eradicating avoidable blindness due to uncorrected refractive errors or diseases of the eye.

On 8-12-21, the team visited their first school which was the TCF school, Moosagoth. This was the start of a successful collaboration between Al-Ibrahim Eye hospital and IMC. Within the same months two other schools were given free eye screenings as well, in other locations. The next month and the next year the collaboration continued with visits to two more schools.

On 21-02-2022, the team visited Nice Grammar English School which was to be their last activity with the collaboration lasting from 2021-2022.

Along with providing screenings, the main aim was to educate impressionable young minds about the importance of eye care and why this is a huge blessing given to us by God Almighty.

This proved to be quite a fruitful collaboration between the two organizations with countless number of lives being impacted very positively. This gave both the organizations even further room to conduct any other activity which had the ability to favorably impact the nation in the future.
