Jamia uloom-ul- asria madrassa was the site where the camp was to be set up, due to its favorable location in being able to cater to many people.

494 surgeries had been carried out with the number of total OPD was 4645.

The numbers were proof that the camp was indeed of some benefit to the people in Jhelum. These camps usually have such a lasting impact to the extent where it was confirmed by a member of the team that the people in the area always look forward and practically wait for this eye camp to be set up due to the level of quality and consistency the team delivers.

The camp ended on 14th march 2023 with a second follow up being scheduled a month later from 13th April- 14th April 2023 in order to address any further concerns the patients might have from the first treatment thereby being able to provide consistency in their area of work and delivering exceptional services that were required of them.
